

EMERGENT ELECTRONIC PROGRAM

The goal of the Emergent Electronic Program is to remove barriers to education by providing funds to eligible applicants for various electronic upgrades needed due to new learning environments. This program will reimburse students for necessary electronics such as computers, peripherals like printers or webcams, and software. This program will be available year-round.

WHO MAY APPLY

The Ulakaia Center (UC) selects the recipients of the Emergent Electronic Program funding. The program is only awarded to applicants that meet one or more of the following criteria:

- A. Aleut Corporation voting Shareholders, defined as: Shareholders who are Native and/or registered descendants of a voting Aleut shareholder.
- B. Registered Descendants of a voting Aleut shareholder, defined as: any lineal descendant of a voting shareholder who has registered with Aleut. (Contact the Shareholder Department at records@aleutcorp.com or visit www.aleutcorp.com/our-shareholders/forms if you need to register a Descendant.)
- C. The categories of eligible applicants set out in A and B above each include an adoptee of a voting Aleut shareholder or a descendant of a voting Aleut shareholder whose adoption occurred prior to the age of majority and is recognized at law or in equity.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- A. Each shareholder/descendant applying for this program must have an account in the Ulakaia Center's scholarship system.
- B. The Emergent Electronics Program is meant to supplement the UC's other educational funding. Applicants for this program must currently be accepted for a general scholarship, vocational scholarship, or career development scholarship.
- C. The complete application must be submitted through the online scholarship system. Incomplete applications will not be processed. A complete application includes the following attachments:
 1. A statement of purpose, explaining why the applicant needs this funding to further the pursuit of their education.
 2. A receipt showing the cost of the electronics or software purchased.
 - i. The purchases must have been made within 90 days of the application.

EMERGENT ELECTRONICS PROGRAM AWARDS

- A. The Ulakaia Center may provide applicants with a reimbursement of up to \$1,000 once per fiscal year (April through March).
- B. UC will review each application and determine whether the purchases fit the intent of this program. A full reimbursement is not guaranteed.
