

UNANGAM TUNUU GRANT

The Unangam Tunuu Grant will aid in cultural awareness by providing funding to individuals that are Shareholders or Descendants of the Aleut Corporation to learn the Aleut language. This grant will be available year-round.

WHO MAY APPLY

The Ulakaia Center (UC) selects the recipients of the Unangam Tunuu Grant. The grant is only awarded to applicants that meet one or more of the following criteria:

- A. Aleut Corporation voting Shareholders, defined as: Shareholders who are Native and/or registered descendants of a voting Aleut shareholder.
- B. Registered Descendants of a voting Aleut shareholder, defined as: any lineal descendant of a voting shareholder who has registered with Aleut. (Contact the Shareholder Department at records@aleutcorp.com or visit www.aleutcorp.com/our-shareholders/forms if you need to register a Descendant.)
- C. The categories of eligible applicants set out in A and B above each include an adoptee of a voting Aleut shareholder or a descendant of a voting Aleut shareholder whose adoption occurred prior to the age of majority and is recognized at law or in equity.

UNANGAM TUNUU GRANT APPLICATION

- A. Each shareholder/descendant applying for this grant must have an account in Ulakaia Center's scholarship system, available on our website.
- B. The complete application must be submitted through the online scholarship system. Incomplete applications will not be processed. A complete application includes the following attachments:
 1. Proof of registration, showing that the applicant is signed up for an Aleut language class. For example: a copy of the confirmation email showing that the applicant is registered for the class.
 2. A personal statement from the applicant briefly explaining their interest in taking an Aleut language class.

UNANGAM TUNUU GRANT AWARD

Applicants selected for awards can receive up to \$1,200 to pay for tuition and fees related to their Aleut language class.

Please note that this grant is designed to allow non-traditional students to take Aleut language courses. The grant is not meant to be combined with our general college scholarship. For example, if a student is taking a full credit load for a term and an Aleut language course is included in that class schedule, they will not be eligible for additional funding (on top of the general scholarship award) through this Unangam Tunuu grant.
